Family Bible Church is in Highland, IL. We are a healthy congregation of about 50-100 Christ-followers. Our Sunday worship services consist primarily of contemporary songs with some traditional hymns. After music, Nursery (newborn-3 years): approx. 5-10, and BLAST (4 years – 5th grade): approx. 8-12 are released to their classrooms, while Jr./Sr. Highschool: approx. 1-5 remain in the service.

We are seeking to support our discipleship ministry through the development of our youth. We are praying for an individual, in a part-time role, to strengthen, lead and serve our children and youth.

- Not afraid to approach the ministry in a way that will resonate with the world we live in, within the guiding principles of the church's beliefs

Qualifications

- A team player, being flexible to the needs of the moment and the period of ministry within the church
- Able to demonstrate integrity through relevant, biblically based studies, activities, and mentorship with the youth of Family Bible Church
- High School Graduate, along with college studies / degree in youth ministry (preferred)

Roles & Responsibilities

- Provide appropriate counseling and spiritual direction
- Seek opportunities to create visibility among students in their everyday social environments
- Developing youth and children ministry programs
- Promote community awareness of Youth Programs, while working with other area youth leaders
- Coordinate activities such as summer camps, retreats, service projects, VBS, and outreach activities
- Gathering/scheduling and equipping volunteers to accomplish the weekly and special events, i.e., creating and/or purchasing weekly lessons
- Work with limited supervision to complete tasks in a timely and orderly fashion
